  - The Entrance Corridor map needs to be formatted with new date and page number.
  - Woolen Mills Conservation District was approved on 9/5/2017 so document will need to be updated to reflect.
  - West Main and North Belmont are anticipated to receive National Register Designation prior to the Comp Plan completion so that will be updated as needed.
