ACCEPTABLE ITEMS TO BE RECYCLED

PAPER PRODUCTS

Paper towel and toilet paper tubes, newspapers and inserts, catalogs and magazines, printer paper, shredded paper, construction and notebook paper, cardboard, paper bags, and pizza boxes

GLASS JARS & BOTTLES

Food & beverage jars and bottles

ALUMINUM & TIN

Tin and bi-metallic containers, aluminum cans, tin food cans, empty aerosol cans, clean aluminum foil, empty pie plates, and food trays

PLASTICS #1 to #7

EXAMPLES:

- #1 PET:** soft drink bottles and condiment bottles
- #2 HDPE:** drink bottles and household cleaners
- #3 PVC:** rigid packaging (blisters packs & clamshells)
- #4 LDPE:** toys and squeezable bottles
- #5 PP:** food containers and medicine bottles
- #6 PS:** plasticware and packaging materials
- #7 Mixed:** 3 and 5 gallon reusable water bottles

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

NO trash, NO diapers, NO clothing, NO styrofoam,
NO plastic bags, NO caps or lids, NO food, NO
compost, NO yard waste
