Current Guidelines and Application Form

Criteria for Funding: Grants will be awarded for a wide variety of activities that promote the mission of the CSCC. Grants may range in size up to \$2,500. Fundraising events are ineligible. Funds must be used within one year of receipt and expenditures must be detailed in the year-end report made to the CSCC.

Eligibility: Applications may be submitted by individuals or groups. When submitting a group application, please designate one contact person. Previous award recipients are eligible to apply after one year. Sister Cities Commissioners and sub-committee members may not apply.

Application: Please complete the attached application and email to cvillesistercities@gmail.com or mail to Charlottesville Sister Cities Commission c/o Paige Rice, P.O. Box 911, Charlottesville, VA 22902. Applications are limited to a maximum of four pages.

Application Deadlines: CSCC grants will be awarded annually. The 2016-17 application deadline is September 30, 2016. Applications must be received electronically by these dates to receive consideration. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Grant recipients will be notified within 30 days of the deadline dates, but may be asked for further information at that time.

Mission Impact: Applications should identify how the proposed project will impact the mission of the Charlottesville Sister Cities Commission.

Project Timeline: Applications should detail activities that will be completed within twelve months of receiving the grant and explain how these activities will accomplish the proposal's objectives, and how the impact will be measured and reported.

Budget: The budget should detail uses of the requested funds and list all other funding sources.

Selection Process: The Charlottesville Sister Cities Grant Committee will review all applications that meet the above guidelines. The full CSCC will conduct final reviews of applications and make awards.
