

FAQs - Summer Camp 2019

What do the new camp names mean?

Our camp program is broken into 3 different age groups.

- **Camp Shenandoah** (formerly Camp XL) Rising K-3rd grade during the 2018-2019 school year.
- **Camp Blue Ridge** 4th-6th graders during the 2018-2019 school year should register for this camp.
- **Camp Skyline** 7th-9th graders during the 2018-2019 school year should register for this camp.

How do I know which location to choose?

You may register your child for the location of your choosing; however, we recommend that Camp Shenandoah participants choose the location where they attend school or at the school that it is paired for summer school. The summer school pairings are the following:

- Clark & Burnley Moran
- Greenbrier & Venable
- Johnson & Jackson-Via

When does registration begin?

City of Charlottesville Residents: March 4, 2019

Non-Residents: April 15, 2019

What is the camp cut-off date for registration?

Cut-off for weekly registrations is the Monday (6 calendar days) prior to the desired camp week.

When do I pay?

You may pay for each week separately; however, payment is due at the time of booking. Payment plans are not an option.

Can I register for camp over the phone?

No, due to the amount of information required for camp registration, we do not accept registrations over the phone. You may register in-person or online.

Do you offer financial aid?

Yes, we offer discounts of 25% - 90% on a sliding income scale through the Parks & Recreation scholarship program. To view the details of the program, eligibility and apply online visit www.charlottesville.org/parksandrec. You can also stop by any recreation center or the downtown administration office and get a paper copy of the guidelines and application.

How does the scholarship program work?

Once you submit the application, staff will review the information and determine the level of discount you are eligible for. Staff will then update your account and the discount will automatically be applied during the payment process of the registration. The discounts will work with online or in-person registrations.

What if I already have a Parks & Recreation Scholarship?

If you already have a current Parks & Recreation scholarship you do not need to do anything else. Your approved discount will be applied to the camp fees.

Can I register while I am waiting on my scholarship application to be approved?

Yes, you can register while you are waiting on your scholarship application approval, but you will have to pay the full price and we do not issue a pro-rated refund if you are approved. Therefore, it is best to submit a scholarship application as soon as possible to get approval before you need to register.

What is the deadline for applying for financial aid?

The deadline to submit a scholarship application for summer camps is June 1st.

Will medication that my child has at the school be accessible during summer camp?

We do not have access to medications that are stored by the school. If your child needs to take medication at camp, you must fill out a medication authorization form and provide medication according to the standards listed in the parent/camper handbook.
